## **RECENT REPORTS August 2016**

**31 August:** A sea-watch from the Oban to Barra ferry and return included 300+ **Fulmars**, 16 **Sooty Shearwaters**, *ca* 700 **Manx Shearwaters**, 140+ **Storm Petrels**, 1 **Leach's Petrel**, 17 **Great Skuas**, 4 **Arctic Skuas**, 1 **Puffin**, 1 **Arctic Tern**, 2 'commic' terns, 300+ **Kittiwakes** (Jim Dickson, David Jardine *et al.*).

A sea-watch this morning at Frenchman's Rocks, Islay 07:40 to 10:00 am, (4 x 30 min watches) in south westerly winds 17 to 20 mph, sunny intervals & showers found: 2 Tufted Ducks, 193 Fulmars, 35 Sooty Shearwaters, 3,023 Manx Shearwaters, 363 Northern Gannets (and ca 500 feeding around the rocks), 31 Shags, 8 Red Knots, 8 Turnstones, 2 Great Skuas, 8 Common Guillemots and 23 Kittiwakes - all flying SW (Mike Peacock/Peter Roberts). The adult Pacific Golden Plover showed well again at Middleton, Tiree first thing, retreated to Loch a' Phuill when flushed and then returned later; 3 Ruffs were also there and a Goldcrest was at Carnan Mor (John Bowler). A juvenile Mediterranean Gull was feeding on the sea off Aird, Tiree (Keith Gillon).

**30** August: A late sea-watch off Hynish, Tiree in SSW6 18:30-20:00 produced: 17 Sooty Shearwaters heading SW in 90 mins. Also heading SW, in 1 hr (18:40-19:40): 52 Fulmars, 960 Manx Shearwaters, 1 Storm Petrel, 130 Northern Gannets, 315 large auks, 16 Kittiwakes, 6 Black-tailed Godwits and an Arctic Tern - also a Basking Shark. And 43 juvenile Black-tailed Godwits were on the beach there (Keith Gillon/John Bowler). An early Redwing photographed at Barrapol, Tiree (John Bowler).

On Tiree; the adult **Pacific Golden Plover** was seen again at Middleton this afternoon and juvenile **Curlew Sandpipers** at Gott Bay and Balephetrish Bay (Keith Gillon). Elsewhere on Tiree, singe **Balearic Shearwaters** were off West Hynish and Hynish early this morning and 2 **Sooty Shearwaters** were detected off Hynish among a steady W movement of *ca* 1,000 **Manx Shearwaters** per hour; a juvenile **Curlew Sandpiper** was at Traigh Ghrianal and 77 juvenile **Black-tailed Godwits** and 4 juvenile **Ruffs** were seen around West Tiree in scattered groups during the goose count (John Bowler).

**29 August:** On Tiree today: An adult **Pacific Golden Plover** and 8 juvenile **Ruffs** at Middleton / Sandaig this afternoon. Also a **Balearic Shearwater** flying west past Hynish (Keith Gillon). 8 juvenile **Black-tailed Godwits** and 1 **Ruff** at Caoles; 2 juvenile **Black-tailed Godwits** at Ruaig (John Bowler).

Today at the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll there were 49 **Teal**, 8 **Goosanders**, an **Osprey** and 2 juvenile **Whinchats** (Jim Dickson).

**28 August:** At midday today, a juvenile **Hobby** at Barrapol, Tiree flew south towards Balephuil: a **Merlin** was also there (John Bowler).

**27 August:** The **Kingfisher** was seen again at Kennacraig, Kintyre today and a group of about 100 **Manx Shearwaters** seen from the ferry off Islay (David Jardine).

On Tiree today: a juvenile **Curlew Sandpiper**, 2 juvenile **Black-tailed Godwits** and 3 juvenile **Red Knot** at Clachan (John Bowler); a juvenile **Curlew Sandpiper** at Vaul (Keith Gillon).

**26 August:** On Tiree today: 1 juvenile **Curlew Sandpiper** with 115 **Ringed Plovers**, 144 **Sanderlings** and 30 **Dunlin** at Sorobaidh Bay; 7 juvenile **Ruff** on cut silage at Heylipol; 3 juvenile **Black-tailed Godwits** at Loch an Eilein; 6 juvenile **Black-tailed Godwits** at Loch a' Phuill; 1 **Goldcrest** still at Balephuil (John Bowler). Also 2 juvenile **Curlew Sandpipers** still at The Green and a **Balearic Shearwater** flew west off The Green (Dante Shepherd).

**25 August:** A noisy **Whimbrel** flying around the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll this morning and a **Blackcap** was in the garden at Cairnbaan (Jim Dickson). Two **Ruffs** and 10 **Black-tailed Godwits** on Luing, Mid-Argyll today (David Jardine).

**24 August:** The **Green Sandpiper** reappeared briefly Machrihanish Seabird Observatory, Kintyre today (Eddie Maguire/ Miriam Lord). Also there, a **Greenshank** and a total of 10 **Curlew Sandpipers** flying S with groups of **Dunlins** (80) throughout the day and 4 were photographed on the shore. The first-winter **Mediterranean Gull** is still present.

On Tiree today: a **Pied Flycatcher** at Carnan Mor and a **Goldcrest** at Balephuil; 1 juvenile **Curlew Sandpiper** at Miodar; 1 juvenile **Curlew Sandpiper** at The Green; 411 **Sanderlings** on the 4 main beaches including 3 leg-flagged birds; 1 **Greenshank** at Loch a' Phuill; 3 **Wigeon** at Loch Bhasapol; 6 juvenile **Blacktailed Godwits** at Ruaig (John Bowler).

**23 August:** Bill was surprised to see this **Nuthatch** on his bird feeder at Bellanoch, Mid-Argyll this evening - a first there in 20 years (Bill Alexander).

On Tiree today: a roost of 260 **Pied Wagtails** at Balephuil (John Bowler); 2 **Curlew Sandpipers** at The Green; 2 **Ruffs** and 2 **Curlew Sandpipers** at Caoles (Dante Shepherd). Also, 1 **Balearic Shearwater**, and 3,500 **Manx Shearwaters** as well as 30 Common Dolphins, 14 Porpoises and 6 Basking Sharks between Coll and Tiree and, at the E end of the Sound of Mull, 1 **Arctic Skua**, 1,250 **Kittiwakes** and 13 Porpoises (John Bowler).

A **Nuthatch** has been regularly visiting a bird feeder at Strone (Holy Loch), Cowal - latest sighting 10:00 today (John Black).

At Machrihanish Seabird Observatory, Kintyre today: a **Great Northern Diver** (immature) flying S, 17 **Curlew Sandpipers** flying S (+ 4 on the shore) along with a **Black-tailed Godwit**, 7 **Ruddy Turnstones**, 10 **Red Knot**, 10 **Sanderlings**, 51 **Dunlins** and 17 **Common Redshanks**. Also a very vocal **Green Sandpiper** came in off the sea (Eddie Maguire).

**22 August:** On Tiree today: the juvenile **Spotted Sandpiper** still at Balephetrish Bay (also on 19 Aug); 3 juvenile **Curlew Sandpipers** at the Green; 2 juvenile **Curlew Sandpipers** and 1 **Ruff** at Caoles (Dante Shepherd). Another record breaking day at Machrihanish Seabird Observatory, Kintyre, with a total of ca 70+ **Curlew Sandpipers** flying south + 8 on the shore: other waders included 30 **Ringed Plover**, 65 **Red Knot**, 90 **Sanderling**, 10 **Ruddy Turnstones**, 33 **Common Redshanks** and 40 **Dunlin** (Eddie Maguire).

**21 August:** A red letter day for passage waders at Machrihanish Seabird Observatory, Kintyre, with a total of 39 **Curlew Sandpipers** flying S + 16 birds offpassage (**total 55**) - the most Curlew Sandpipers so far recorded in Argyll in a single day. Other waders moving south were: 28 **Ringed Plovers**, 12 **Ruddy Turnstones**, 33 **Red Knots**, 170 **Sanderlings**, 400+ **Dunlins** and 60 **Common Redshanks** (Eddie Maguire).

A short visit to Gigha, Kintyre this afternoon produced; at Ardminish Bay – 71 **Ringed Plovers**, 1 Whimbrel, 1 **Red Knot**, 9 **Common Redshanks**, 31 **Sandwich Terns**, 8 **Common Terns**, 2 **Arctic Terns**, 40 **Kittiwakes**; at Caolas Gigalum – 3 **Common Sandpipers**, 14 **Common Redshanks**, 17 **Sandwich Terns** and at Drumyeonmore – a fledged brood of **Bullfinches**. Later off Rhunahaorine Point: 50+ **Common Scoter**, 1 **Black-throated Diver**, 6 **Slavonian Grebes** (David Jardine).

An **Osprey** was at Bun an Uilt, Loch Gruinart, Islay (Mike Peacock).

**20 August:** Two juvenile **Curlew Sandpipers** at Sorobaidh Bay, Tiree today (Dante Shepherd).

A single **Common Swift** was with a group of 30 or more passage Barn Swallows and House Martins over Tullochgorm (Minard), Mid-Argyll at 08:00 this morning (Paul Daw).

Three **Greenshanks** at north end of Caol Scotnish (Loch Sween), Mid-Argyll this afternoon (Dougie Menzies).

At the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll this afternoon: 6 **Wigeon**, 8 **Ringed Plovers**, 52 **Black-tailed Godwits**, 4 **Red Knot**, 1 **Ruff (reeve)**, 44 **Dunlins**, 24 **Common Redshanks**, 4 **Whinchats**, 16 **Stonechats**, 4 **Northern Wheatears** and 1 **White Wagtail** (Jim Dickson).

Highlights of a WeBS Count at Loch Gilp: 2 **Wigeon**, 3 **Red Knot**, 1 **Little Stint**, 4 **Greenshanks** and at Loch a' Chroisg, Ford, Mid-Argyll – 2 **Mandarin Duck** (female & 1 immature) (David Jardine).

In a strong easterly wind / continuous rain at Machrihanish Seabird Observatory, Kintyre today, waders in off the sea all morning included: 50 **Ringed Plovers**, 4 **Black-tailed Godwits**, a **Whimbrel**, 22 **Dunlins**, at least 18 **Curlew Sandpipers**, 31 **Red Knot**, 40 **Ruddy Turnstones**, 290 **Common Redshanks**, Also, a juvenile **Mediterranean Gull** for its second day, 2 adult **Sandwich Terns** and a juvenile **Arctic Tern** (Eddie Maguire).

**17 August:** An adult **Green Sandpiper** was at Teddy's Pond, Balvicar, Seil, Mid-Argyll at 16:00 today (John Sedgwick).

The juvenile **Spotted Sandpiper** was found again, west of Ard Mor, Tiree this morning (John Bowler/Dante Shepherd): it was seen back at Balephetrish Bay this evening (Dante Shepherd).

Also **Grey Plover**, **Black-tailed Godwit** and juvenile **Red Knot** singles at Balephetrish Bay this morning (John Bowler).

**16 August:** Four **Common Swifts** over Kilmartin, Mid-Argyll today - flying around the church tower (Jim Dickson).

**15 August:** Hirundine and swift passage noted high in the sky over Cairnbaan, Mid-Argyll from 18:00 (although may have been going on all day??). At least 100+ **Barn Swallows**, 10+ **House Martins** and 14+ **Common Swifts** in 1 hour (Jim Dickson).

On Tiree today: 8 **Common Terns** including 2 juveniles at Gott Bay; a juvenile **Red Knot** and a **Greenshank** at Balephetrish Bay; 2 **Greenshanks** at Loch an Eilein, a **White Wagtail** at Vaul, a juvenile **Common Cuckoo**, a **Robin** and a **Common Redpoll** at Balephuil; an adult **Moorhen** at Kilkenneth. But sadly no sign of yesterday's Spotted Sandpiper (John Bowler).

**13 August:** On Coll today: a short evening sea-watch at Arinagour pier 18:30-19:00 hrs found 1,000 **Manx Shearwaters** and a single **European Storm Petrel**. Also single **Whimbrel** on the Golf Course, 6 **Sand Martins** at machair near Breachacha, 3 **Goldfinches** at Ballyhaugh and proof of breeding for **Wood Pigeon** at the Lodge, Arinagour (David Jardine).

On Tiree today: a **Hen Harrier** and a **Common Cuckoo** at Balinoe; a **Whimbrel** at Sandaig: 2 **Whimbrel**, 3 **Bar-tailed Godwits**, 61 **Turnstones**, 1 juvenile **Red Knot**, 42 **Dunlin**, and 2 **Arctic Terns** at Clachan / Balephetrish Bay; 1 **Sparrowhawk** and a **Robin** at Balephuil (John Bowler).

At the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll today: a second calendar year **Hen Harrier**, 11 **Ringed Plovers**, 4 juvenile **Black-tailed Godwits**, 1 **Red Knot**, 1 **Sanderling**, 17 **Dunlins**, 2 **Greenshanks**, 3 **Common Swifts**, 48 **Barn** 

Swallows, 2 House Martins, 1 Blackcap and 2 Common Whitethroats. At Loch Gilp, Mid-Argyll: 15 Ringed Plovers, 1 Whimbrel, 5 Bar-tailed Godwits, 1 Greenshank, and 1 Grey Wagtail. And at Cairnbaan, Mid-Argyll: 1 Blackcap (Jim Dickson).

Later at Loch Gilp: 7 **Red Knot** and 3 **Greenshanks**, and at the Add Estuary: 3 **Common Sandpipers** (John Halliday).

A **Jay** in a garden at Bullwood Road, Dunoon today was the first they'd seen there (Cherry Cook).

Today a flock of at least 70 **Goldfinches** flew west over Strone Farm, Otter Ferry, Cowal (Tom Callan).

A single **Greenshank** was at the Holy Loch, Dunoon this morning (George Newall).

**12 August:** A sea-watch at Machrihanish Seabird Observatory, Kintyre, 07:30-14:30 hrs., with poor visibility / WSW, f4. **Northern Gannets** were again inshore on a narrow-front, on passage south. A **total of 2,208** had passed south by 10:30hrs (largest loose flock was 48). Also a juvenile **Little Gull** dip-feeding offshore and 3 adult **Sandwich Terns** and 22 adult **Black Guillemots** flew south (best passage of the latter there for many years) (Eddie Maguire).

At the Add Estuary/Loch Crinan, Mid-Argyll: 1 Little Grebe, 6 Golden Plover,

6 Ringed Plovers, 1 Whimbrel, 7 Red Knot,

21 **Dunlins**, 1 **Greenshan**k, 12 **Common Snipe**,and 1 **Osprey**. At Loch Gilp, Mid-Argyll: 5 **Turnstones**, 6 **Red Knot**, 1 **Greenshank**, 65 **Common Redshanks**, and 8 juvenile **Common Terns** (Jim Dickson).

A single **Common Cuckoo** was at Balephuil, Tiree today (John Bowler).

11 August: Today 1,800 Northern Gannets were noted passing the Machrihanish Seabird Observatory, Kintyre in 3 hrs (one very early juvenile seen) (Eddie Maguire). At Loch Gilp, Mid-Argyll this morning: 3 Whimbrels, 5 Bar-tailed Godwits, 6 Turnstones, 2 Red Knot, 1 Sanderling and 185 Oystercatchers. At the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll: 3 Goosanders, 2 Ringed Plovers, 3 Red Knot, 1 Sanderling, 4 Dunlins, and 4 Common Sandpipers (Jim Dickson). A juvenile Ruff was along the Arileod Straight, Coll today (Neil Cowie).

**10 August:** Two **Grasshopper Warblers** reeling at Stronafian, near Colintraive, Cowal today and a **Tree Pipit** in Clachaig, nr. Dunoon. Also a juvenile **Little Gull** on Holy Loch (Neil Hammatt).

At the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll today: 2 **Common Terns** and a **Kittiwake** - both very unusual there (Jim Dickson).

A juvenile **Ruff** was near Little Feall Bay, Coll today (Ben Jones/Neil Cowie). There are very few records of this species from Coll, although they've perhaps gone underreported in the past (John Bowler).

## **o8** August: Northern Gannet: overland passage in S Kintyre.

On o8 August, a large number of Northern Gannets were plunge-diving for fish immediately inshore of MSBO all day: suspiciously, single birds were occasionally noted flying from the east. Gannets are known to fly 9 km across The Laggan from Campbeltown Loch to Machrihanish to join any large foraging activity.

A coordinated watch was organised at MSBO (Eddie Maguire / Iomhar McMillan) and at Campbeltown Loch (Rab Morton).

At 13:52 hrs Eddie's mobile rang: Rab announced from his vantage point at Dalintober Pier (Campbeltown) that a high-flying adult was on its way over the peninsula and, that it had disappeared rapidly, to the west, over the town.

At 14:01 hrs 4 adults were seen flying west towards the Atlantic over the Ugadale Hotel in Machrihanish village and another adult arrived from the east via The Laggan at 14:10 hrs. 100% evidence indeed!

Overland passage in Scotland from Forth to Clyde has been assumed but never proven like this (Eddie Maguire). See Maguire, E. (2015): *Westerly overland passage of Northern Gannets in south Argyll 2007-2015*: The Eider, December 2015 (No. 114).

- **o8** August: A hectic sea-watch this morning 05:45-07:45 hrs off Aird, Tiree in NW7 produced: a blizzard of 23,530 Manx Shearwaters (20,710 in the first hour!), 89 Fulmars, one European Storm-petrel, 272 Northern Gannets,

  1 Pomering Skyre, 2 Creat Skyres, 1 Puffin, 1 Plack Cyillomet, 18 large cylings.
- 1 **Pomarine Skua**, 8 **Great Skuas**, 1 **Puffin**, 1 **Black Guillemot**, 12 large auks, 2 **Little Terns** and 22 **Kittiwakes**. Also, a juvenile **Ruff** with Lapwings at Hough, an adult **Moorhen** at Kilkenneth and the **Wood Pigeon** again at Balephuil (John Bowler).

A blustery 7 hr sea-watch (NW f5 bright n' breezy - no squalls) at Machrihanish Seabird Observatory, Kintyre 07:30-14:30 hrs today produced: 7 **European Stormpetrels** flying S (singles, all a.m.), a female **Sparrowhawk**,

140 **Oystercatchers** along with 44 **Dunlins** and 16 **Sanderlings** flying S; 165 of 414 **Black-legged Kittiwakes** flying S on narrow front inshore passage were juveniles (40%) and 4 **Sandwich Terns** were sheltering, including a juvenile (Eddie Maguire).

At the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll this afternoon: 22 juvenile **Black-tailed Godwits** were newly arrived. Also there were 6 **Ringed Plovers**, 9 **Dunlins**, 4 **Common Sandpipers**, an **Osprey** and 3 juvenile **Whinchats**. An **Arctic Skua** was out in the Sound of Jura and a female/immature **Common Redstart** was near Dalvore (Moine Mhor), Mid-Argyll (Jim Dickson).

**07 August:** A sea-watch from Crinan harbour, Mid-Argyll looking into the sound of Jura produced 66 **Manx Shearwaters** and 3,500+ **Kittiwakes** and in one hour this morning. By Slockavullin school, Mid-Argyll; a family of 6 **Spotted Flycatchers** with 2 **Northern Wheatears** and 18 **Pied Wagtails** nearby. At Loch Gilp, Mid-Argyll; 1 **Whimbrel**, 3 **Bar-tailed Godwits** and 2 **Greenshanks** (Jim Dickson).

The pick of a 7hr sea-watch at Machrihanish Seabird Observatory, Kintyre, SW - W f5 (6 at times), was a pair of **Gadwall**, *ca.* 200 **Manx Shearwaters**, a Whimbrel, a pale adult **Arctic Skua**, the first juvenile **Black-legged Kittiwakes** of the year (2) and 3 **Sandwich Terns** including a squeaking juvenile (Eddie Maguire).

**o6 August:** Two **Spotted Flycatchers** this morning near Duntrune gardens, Mid-Argyll Also, 3 **White Wagtails** accompanying *ca* 10 **Pied Wagtails** at the Add Estuary (Jim Dickson).

A rewarding sea-watch in SSE7, with the odd shower, off Hynish, Tiree at 16:30-17:30 hrs found: 2 Sooty Shearwaters, 2,750 Manx Shearwaters, 12 European Storm-petrels, 392 Northern Gannets, 1 Arctic Skua, 26 large auks (Common Guillemot/Razorbill), 2 Black Guillemots, 234 Puffins and 82 Kittiwakes (all birds heading SW). Also 1 Wood Pigeon at Balephuil – it probably summered here which is most unusual (John Bowler).

**o5 August:** This afternoon there were 5 **Greenshanks** at the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll and 2 at Loch Gilp (Jim Dickson).

On Tiree today: an **Osprey** briefly at Loch a' Phuill this morning was probably the same as one heading west past Milton last night. Also a **Greenshank** at Loch an Eilein, a **Grasshopper Warbler** still reeling at Balephuil and an immature **Moorhen** at Moss (John Bowler).

A single **Common Kingfisher** was seen at Garmony, Mull today, on a burn running into the Sound of Mull. Also a **Common Goldeneye** at Bunessan (Alan

Spellman).

**o4 August:** At the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll this morning a notable increase in **Common Redshanks** with 71 birds (mostly juveniles), also 3 **Dunlins**, 4 **Common Sandpipers** and still 3 **Greenshanks**. Nearby 2 juvenile **Whinchats** and good numbers of **Meadow Pipits** and **Pied Wagtails** (Jim Dickson).

An **Osprey** was heading west past Milton, Tiree this evening –a **Great Northern Diver**, a **Common Sandpiper**, an **Arctic Skua** and a **Great Skua** were also there (John Bowler).

**03 August:** At Loch Gilp, Mid-Argyll this morning; 3 **Bar-tailed Godwits** (including 2 'reddish' adults) and 24 **Common Redshanks**. At the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll, an **Osprey**, 16 **Common Redshanks** and a **Greenshank** (Jim Dickson).

**o2 August:** an adult female **Marsh Harrier** was put up by a male **Hen Harrier**, in the boggy field at Lochdon, Mull, just past the Grasspoint turnoff (per Alan Spellman).

At the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll today were 2 **Hen Harriers** (a second calendar year male and ring-tail) and a single **Greenshank** was on the river (Jim Dickson). Later at the Add Estuary, 3 **Greenshanks** and 3 **Ospreys** fishing and, at the head of Loch Sween, 2 **Northern Gannets** (John Halliday).

8 **Moorhens** (6 adults, 2 immature) and a **Water Rail** at Ardencaple, Seil Island, Mid-Argyll this evening (David Jardine).

**O1 August:** A **Sooty Shearwater** and 3 **Great Skuas** off Gunna Sound at midday from the Tiree-Coll ferry: also 10 **Basking Sharks** and a **Minke Whale** there (John Bowler).
