31 October: Tiree: 1 **Yellow-browed Warbler** still at Balephuil with 1 **Goldcrest**, 15 **Goldfinch** and 60 **Redwings** there. A big movement of **Whooper Swans** with flocks passing through all day. 257 **Whooper Swans** at Loch a' Phuill plus 12 **Shovelers** there. 54 **Whooper Swans** and 1 **Little Grebe** at Loch an Eilein. 1 **Jack Snipe** at The Reef (John Bowler).

Mull: A **Green Woodpecker** was in pasture on the immediate outskirts of Tobermory (near former Children's farm) this morning at around 11.15 (Stuart Gibson per Alan Spellman).

30 October: Mid-Argyll: A m **Blackcap** in the garden at Cairnbaan this morning (Jim Dickson).

Cowal: wave after wave of **Fieldfares** and **Redwings** flying S.E. over Evanachan Farm (N of Otter ferry) at 3pm. Each 'wave'...around 2 to 300 birds (Yvonne McCrone).

29 October: Mid-Argyll: A **Kingfisher** and a **Dipper** on the Cuilarstich burn at Millers bridge, Lochgilphead this morning (Jim Dickson). Big numbers of **Fieldfares** and **Redwings** at Ormsary this morning (Stu Crutchfield). **Tiree:** 2 **Yellow-browed Warblers** at Balephuil, also 700+ **Redwing**, 30 **Fieldfare**, 2m & 4f **Blackcaps** and 20 **Goldfinch.** 1 **Wheatear** at Mannal (John Bowler).

28 October: Mid-Argyll: This afternoon (15:10-16:50) big numbers of thrushes observed moving west through the Cairnbaan corridor into Knapdale forest. Difficult to count the waves of birds but minimum estimates give: 6,000-7,000 **Redwings**, 3,500-4,000 **Fieldfares**, 70-80 **Blackbirds** and many **Song Thrushes** mixed in and a notable movement of **Chaffinch** with 350+ birds. Also 1 **Jay**, 1 **Great Spotted Woodpecker**, 4 **Bullfinch**, 10 **Goldcrests** and 8 **Long-tailed Tit** noted (Jim Dickson).

Cowal: Around Dunoon most of the thrushes up to now have been **Redwings** but a flock of 100+ **Fieldfares** flew over the house this morning and there were large numbers on Loch Eckside. Also 60+ **Turnstones** at Dunoon Crazy Golf but no Purple Sandpipers so far (George Newall).

Tiree: Still 1 Yellow-browed Warbler at Balephuil today (John Bowler).

27 October: Mid-Argyll: 1,250 **Fieldfares** and 300 **Redwings** in Knapdale forest opposite the Cairnbaan hotel (Jim Dickson).

Kintyre: A juvenile **Surf Scoter** was photographed flying past Machrihanish Seabird Observatory this morning (Eddie Maguire).

Tiree: 1 **Yellow-browed Warbler** still at Balephuil, also 10 **Goldfinch** there. A **Barn Owl** last night at Crossapol (John Bowler).

25 October: Mid-Argyll: recent reports of 1-2 **Kingfishers** around Loch Gilp (Miller's Bridge to canal at Ardrishaig) (Colin MacFarlane). **Tiree:** 2 **Yellow-browed Warblers**, 2 Fieldfares,1f Blackcap and 1 Woodcock at Balephuil. 2m **Pochard** at Loch a' Phuill. 1m **Pochard** and 2f **Pintail** at Loch an Eilein (John Bowler/Andy Robinson).

24 October: Mid-Argyll: At Barsloisnoch 1 **Pink-footed Goose** and 260 **Fieldfares**. Increase in numbers of **Blackbirds** with 40+ in the Cairnbaan area. At Loch Gilp 485 **Wigeon**, 51 **Redshank**, 34 **Ringed Plover**, 3 **Dunlin**, 2 **Red Knot** and 16 **Bar-tailed Godwit** (Jim Dickson).

22 October: Tiree: 1 Blyth's Reed Warbler and 1 Red-breasted Flycatcher new in John Bowler's garden at Balephuil. Also 2 Yellow-browed Warbler still there plus 5 Bramblings, 1f Blackcap and 1 Goldcrest. 1 Waxwing at Hynish and 3 Wheatears at Sorobaidh Bay (John Bowler). Islay: A Yellow-browed Warbler at Kinnabus today and 5 Long-tailed Tits there - my first here in 5 yrs despite being common on the island (David Wood). Mid-Argyll: many small groups of Fieldfares moving NE over Cairnbaan with at least 470 in 2 hours early afternoon (Jim Dickson).

North Argyll: At Loch Laich (Appin) 7 Bar-tailed Gowits, 12 Redshanks, 31 Ringed Plover, 3 Turnstone, 25 Curlew and 23 Oystercatcher. At Columbas Bay (Barcaldine) there were 50 Wigeon and 20 Teal. A nice flock of about 15 Longtailed Tit were near the head of Loch Creran (Robin Harvey).

Tiree: 2 **Yellow-browed Warblers** still at Balephuil plus 15 **Fieldfare**, 60 **Redwing**, 1 **Brambling**, 10 **Goldfinch**, 2m,1f **Blackcap** and 1 **Goldcrest**. 4 **Pale-bellied Brent Geese** at West Hynish. 67 **Whooper Swans** and a **Little Grebe** at Loch a' Phuill (John Bowler). 1 **Long-tailed Duck** off The Maze. 3 **Blackcaps** elsewhere around the island (Toby Green).

Cowal: Passing through Glendaruel today some exciting visible migration (Vis Mig) with Clive McKay noting: 156 **Woodpigeons**, 18 **Blackbirds**,

1,028 Fieldfares and 712 Redwings all streaming north.

20 October: Mid-Argyll: hundreds of **Fieldfares** were flocking in treetops in Connel this morning (Mike Harrison). A fleeting glimpse of a **Kingfisher** over the River Aray below Inveraray Castle this morning (Glyn Toplis).

Tiree: - Balephuil: 3 **Yellow-browed Warblers** still present, 1 **Goldcrest**, 1 female **Blackcap**, 1 **Waxwing**, 45 **Fieldfares**,

60 **Redwings**, 5 **Bramblings** (plus 4 more over south) and 20 **Goldfinches**. More **Greenland White-fronted Geese** flying over S (John Bowler).

- The Glebe: 1 Chiffchaff (Toby Green).

- Milton: 700 Barnacle Geese (Toby Green).

- Vaul: 1 Goldcrest, 1 female Blackcap and 1 Great Tit. (Toby Green).

Cowal: A mix of 100 or more **Fieldfares** and **Redwings** just north of Millhouse crossroads and huge numbers of Auk spp and **Gannets** in the Otter Ferry Narrows over the last few days (Tom Callan).

19 October: Islay: a big arrival of geese at Loch Gruinart RSPB Reserve today. On the reserve: 30,230 **Barnacle Geese**, 119 **Greenland White-fronted Geese**, 2 **Pink-footed Geese**, 2 **Pale-bellied Brent**

Geese, 1 hutchinsii Canada Goose and 1 parvipes Canada Goose (James How).

Mid-Argyll: this Nuthatch was observed at Achnameadhonach, Taynuilt between 7-10th October 2016, appearing several times daily to feed. Achnameadhonach, on the road to Balndore is an isolated decrofted croft, approx 2miles SW of Taynuilt village. Only visited from time to time so it's possible it appeared before and after these dates. The first Nuthatch Hazel has seen in Argyll (Hazel Campbell).

240 Redwings, 2 Bramblings, 1 Common Redpoll and 20 Goldfinches.

- The Glebe : 1 Chiffchaff and 60 Redwings.

- Heylipol Church: 1 Goldcrest and 1 immature Ring Ouzel.

- Loch an Eilein: 40 Whooper Swans.

- Sorobaidh Bay creek: 2 Swallows and 1 female Blackcap.

Hundreds of **Barnacle Geese** and **Greenland White-fronted Geese** flew south over the island all morning in flocks of up to 70 – also 807 **Barnacle Geese** at Balephetrish and 55 **Greenland White-fronts** at the Reef (John Bowler).
