On Tiree: a **Common Whitethroat** and a **Willow Warbler** at Balephuil (John Bowler), 8 juvenile **Red Knot** at Vaul (Graham Todd).

o5 September: A **Green Woodpecker** was seen near Stonefield Farm, Glenmassan, Dunoon today – the first record for some time from this key area for the species in Argyll (Alistair McGregor).

A single **Nuthatch** on a bird feeder in a garden at Glenmassan, Dunoon returned several times during the day (Gordon Rothero).

An **Osprey** fishing at West Loch Tarbert, Kintyre, opposite the West Loch hotel at 12:30, circling and fishing for 20 minutes (Steven Herrington).

Today on Tiree: a juvenile **Buff-breasted Sandpiper** again on the machair at Sandaig today with 2 juvenile **Curlew Sandpipers** (Graham Todd). Also the immature **Turtle Dove** at Main Road Farm, Balephuil; a second calendar year **Iceland Gull** at Barrapol (the summering bird); a juvenile **Black-tailed Godwit** and 3 juvenile **Ruffs** at Kilmoluaig; a flock of 22 juvenile **Bar-tailed Godwits** at Loch a' Phuill was unusual but no sign of the 4 Buff-breasted Sandpipers there. A 1hr sea-watch from Hynish in SSE7 with rain 07:50-08:50hrs produced (all heading SW): 26 **Fulmars**, 6 **Sooty Shearwaters**, 680 **Manx Shearwaters**, 1 **Storm Petrel**, 10 **Common Snipe**, 320 large auks, 1 **Arctic Tern**, 92 **Kittiwakes** (inc. 66 juveniles): also 1 juvenile **Curlew Sandpiper** at Hynish first thing. Later; 2 **House Martins** at Balephuil and 220 **Twite** coming to roost there (John Bowler).

O4 September: A solitary **Magpie** at Clachan Seil, Seil island, Mid-Argyll at 18:00 hrs was the first John had seen on Seil in 16 years (John Sedgwick). An obvious fall of migrants on Tiree today (and last night) included: 4 juvenile **Buff-breasted Sandpipers** together at Loch a' Phuill; 1 juvenile **Buff-breasted Sandpiper** still at Sandaig; an immature **Turtle Dove**, 1 **Common Whitethroat**, 3 **Sedge Warblers**, 1 **Reed Warbler**, 3 **Robins**, and 1 **Pied Flycatcher** at Balephuil; a **Goldcrest** and a **Lapland Bunting** south over Carnan Mor; juvenile **Mediterranean Gull** headed north at Balemartine as well as 16+ **Greenland Wheatears** and 8+ **White Wagtails** (John Bowler). And late on 03 Sep: a **Lesser Whitethroat** and a **Reed Warbler** at Balephuil (John Bowler); a juvenile **Curlew Sandpiper** at Hynish and **Brent Geese** heard at night in flight at Scarinish (Keith Gillon).

o3 September: A **Marsh Harrier** was seen on the south side of Loch Gorm, Islay today (Paul Graham per Ian Brooke): one seen earlier, at Kilchoman on 27 August, was presumably the same bird (Ian and Margaret Brooke).

Today at Frenchman's Rocks, Islay 07:40 - 10:15 (4 x 30 min watches), wind SSW 16 – 18 mph, birds all flying SW: 2 Mallards, 1 Great Northern Diver, 126 Fulmars, 8 Sooty Shearwaters, 465 Manx Shearwaters, 1 Balearic Shearwater, 1,122 Northern Gannets (and ca 250 feeding around Frenchman's rock in tidal race), 8 Great Cormorants, 8 Shags, 8 Turnstones, 2 Great Skuas, 1 Razorbill, 10 Common Guillemots (+ 11 large auks), 5 Kittiwakes, 25 Lesser Black-backed Gulls and 50 Twite feeding on short grass at the point. Also a Sparrowhawk on the croft area (Mike Peacock/Peter Roberts).

And on Tiree today: the juvenile **Buff-breasted Sandpiper** again - on the machair at Sandaig this am with 1 juvenile **Black-tailed Godwit** and 5 juvenile **Red Knot**. Also, 1 **Corncrake**, 2 **Goldcrests**, juvenile **Grasshopper Warbler**, 3 **Common Redpoll** at Balephuil/Carnan Mor

And second calendar year **Iceland Gull** at Traigh Ghrianal; 2 juvenile **Red Knots**, 2 juvenile **Curlew Sandpipers** and a **Common Tern** at Clachan; 30+ **Blacktailed Godwits** at Kilmoluaig (Keith Gillon).

o2 September: A **Buff-breasted Sandpiper** arrived at Middleton, Tiree this afternoon (Keith Gillon). Also 6 **Ruff** there but no sign yet of the Pacific Golden Plover (John Bowler).

Hundreds of Manx Shearwaters, Common Guillemots, Gannets, Shags and Kittiwakes seen in the Sound of Jura from the Islay ferry; also a **Sooty Shearwater** and 3 **Great Skuas** (Colin MacFarlane).

A **Stock Dove** this morning at Blarbuie farm, just NE of Lochgilphead golf course, Mid-Argyll It then flew NW towards Cnoc Mor. At the Add Estuary, Mid-Argyll midafternoon: 8 **Ringed Plovers**, 1 **Red Knot**, 1 **Sanderling**, 32 **Dunlins** and a group of 79 **Common Redshanks** had just arrived (Jim Dickson).

O1 September: This colour-ringed **Oystercatcher** was seen at the head of Loch Gilp, Mid-Argyll today. We're waiting to hear where it was ringed from the BTO and have asked Harry Scott....a bird ringed in Aberdeenshire last year appeared on the same rock and possibly another from there? (Jim Dickson).
